

Heart Rending and Pathetic story of Oppression and Terror caused by Janmach at Kalinganagar



Janmanch, a self-proclaimed organisation of public service is an oppressive, self-centered profit motivated gang of several vagues. In the name of Tribal wellfair it is causing damage to the development process of Tribal people. It opposes industrialisation and amasses money from industrialists, contractors and anybody who comes their way, some of

them are also contractors too! This organisation is a gang to loot, lead a luxurious life, cheat the simple Tribals, kill, injure and rape. Thus the gang is a menace, it creates havoc in Kalinganagar. Some examples of their terror and oppression are worth-mentioning.

Some rogues of Janamancha attempted to kill Bira Hesa and rape Basanti Badra in Duburi market. Cases have lodged in these

attempts. They have murdered Shreedhar Soi. Nine accused persons have been arrested for this murder. Janamancha people Bana Barla, Jogendra Kamuda and some others have looted the property of Jagabandhu Tamasoi, injured five persons of his family of Chandia village. As Janamancha people did not allow Sanjay, son of Chamara Soi of Gobarghati to move to a hospital, he died of

brain fever. Though cases are pending in Orissa High Court against Janamancha, their gundas attempted to murder Jagabandhu Soi, Narayan Tiyu and Murali Mallick of Tribal families. Parbati Rana of Bhuban has lost her eyesight being attacked by Janamancha people. About 250 tribal families were deprived from possessing their household materials from their own home. However, admini-

stration and the police have come to their aid and they have brought their materials to their newly settled location, destroying their old houses. These tribal people were of Chandia, Gadpur, Baligotha, Bamiangotha close to Kalinganagar.

It is worth-mentioning that Kalinganagar, the "wold steel centre", once occupied and controlled by Janamancha's rogues people

(about one hundred) of Chandia and Baligotha. This activity of Janamancha caused a hundred crore loss to the public property per year. These people mainly from Chandia and Baligotha openly had challenged political people, democracy and administration. Continuously for four years Janamancha oppressed and terrorised the locality. Even the police could not enter the area. Till

now Janamancha people speak against state and national leaders in print media. One of the main leaders of Janamancha, Anna Reddy (Janashakti, CPI leader and General Secretary) engaged in unsocial activities here has been arrested by the police. Leaders, VIPs including women fold of this area have appealed the Governor and Chief Minister of Orissa. They have also appealed

the Human Rights commissioner against the criminal activities of Janamancha. Unless these criminal activities of Janamancha is not checked and if they are not completely rooted, industrialisation of Kalinganagar will be a shattered dream only, thereby, keeping this area of tribals as undeveloped as ever. Now all wait to see the firm resolution and hard task to be taken up by the administration.
